

- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:30 p.m.
Invocation And Pledge Of Allegiance
The invocation was given by Ms. Deidre Maples and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.
- II. Announcements - Deidre Maples announced that the repairs of the basement at the Presbyterian Church were complete
- III. No presentations were made by citizens.
- IV. Consent Agenda
David Petty moved to approve the consent agenda. Doug Simmerman seconded, the motion passed 3-0.
- V. New Business
 - A) David Petty moved to approve the 2015-2016 Annual Audit as prepared by Conway Company CPAs PC. Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 3-0.
 - B) David Petty moved to approve Ordinance 2017-01-001 adopting the Sulphur Springs News Telegram as the City's official newspaper. Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 3-0.
- VI. Reports
 - A) Police Department
Paul Robertson stated there were 347 total citations issued in December with 25 calls for service, 2 vehicle crashes, 7 offense reports, and 9 arrests. Cumby Elementary Student Council donated \$600.00 for a vest for Amigo. To date there is \$129,000.00 in seizure funds that have been collected with disbursement of the City portion awaiting prosecution.
 - B) Maintenance Department
Water leaks were repaired, sewer lines blown out, electrical problems at the wastewater plant, water leak to be repaired on Mill Street and the water loss for December was 7.17 percent.
 - C) Fire Department
Interim Chief Heath McCraw submitted a report for the month of December with 12 grass fires, 1 car fire, 1 structure fire, 9 medical calls, 3 motor vehicle accidents, 2 investigation/standbys with 7 calls in the city and 22 calls in the district.
