- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:33 p.m.
Invocation And Pledge Of Allegiance
The invocation was given by Deidre Maples and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.
- II. Announcements - Mayor Carter announced that the FEMA road project had been completed. Mayor Pro Tem Petty stated that the City was still in the black with an approximate decrease in sales tax revenue of 70 percent. Jackie Holley stated trash around buildings and residences and letters of enforcement need to be sent. Mayor Carter announced that spring cleanup would be March 14th through 18th.

 - B) Cody Talley moved to advertise and offer for sale the 1997 Ford Truck, 2005 Chevrolet, the 2009 Tahoe and the utility trailer through sealed bids with the City reserving the right to reject any and all bids. David Petty seconded, the motion passed 5-0.

Paul Robertson reported for the police department for January as 315 traffic citations issued, 2 arrests, 4 accident assists, 3 offense reports, 2 incident reports and 1 stolen vehicle recovered.
 - B) Public Works
Johnny Carter reported 3 water leaks, 2 sewer lines repaired, urinal at the park bathroom broken, a water tap was installed, he and Silas attended a webinar on sample site planning, meter reading was completed. System totals report was submitted for the utility system showing water sold, gallons of water pumped and the loss for January as 11.66 percent.
