

- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:31 p.m.  
Invocation And Pledge Of Allegiance  
The invocation was given by Deidre Maples and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.
- II. Announcements - Mayor Carter announced that letters had been mailed to individuals for enforcement of cleanup of property and the City's spring cleanup would be March 14<sup>th</sup> through 19<sup>th</sup>. Republic Services would be providing hot dogs and drinks on March 19<sup>th</sup> to the citizens.

  - B) Cody Talley moved to purchase a new truck for the maintenance department and to authorize the Mayor to sign loan documentation required for the purchase. Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 3-0.
  - C) No presentation on forfeiture expense, Chief Robertson had been called away for an emergency.

  - A) Police Department

  - B) Public Works  
Johnny Carter reported 6 water leaks, 7 sewer lines repaired, new grinder pump installed at the lift station, new parts on chlorination system, electronic meters are being replaced with new ones. System totals report was submitted for the utility system showing the water sold, gallons of water pumped and the water loss for February as 18.91 percent. Mayor Carter state that TCEQ performed water system inspection and the inspector had concerns due to previous inspection but was impressed by the dramatic improvements. Mayor Carter thanked the staff, council and the attorney for assistance with the inspection.
