I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:30 p.m.

Invocation And Pledge Of Allegiance

The invocation was given by Jackie Holley and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.

- II. Announcements - Mayor Carter announced that the Cumby Robotics Team won first in division and third in the world and CBS news would be in Cumby on Thursday May 11th to do a news story on the team. Consent Agenda

V. Reports

A) Police Department

Chief Roberson reported the police department activity for March as 359 citations issued, 34 calls for service, 4 offense reports, 5 warrant arrests and 4 arrests for possession of controlled substance with activity for April as 319 citations, 38 calls for service, 13 offense reports, 1 incident report, 6 arrests and 23 warnings mailed out to residences for code violations.

B) Public Works

Johnny Carter submitted that leaks were repaired, sewer lines unstopped, storage tank repairs being made and the maintenance department is working at the park for preparation of Blackjack Grove Day. System totals report was submitted for the utility system showing the water sold, gallons of water pumped and the water loss for March as 4.51 percent and April as 5.64 percent.

C) Fire Department


Chief Heath McGraw submitted the report for March as 4 grass fires, 1 car fire, 2 structure fires, 7 medical calls, 5 motor vehicle accidents, 4 investigation/standbys with 1 call in the City and 21 in the district. There were 2 grass fires, 1 structure fire, 9 medical calls, 9 motor vehicle accidents, 4 investigation/standbys with 4 calls in the City and 18 in the district for the month of April.
