


Regular Meeting Minutes of the City Council of the City of Cumby



- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:33 p.m.
Invocation And Pledge Of Allegiance
The invocation was given by Jackie Holley and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.
- II. Announcements - Mayor Carter announced that FEMA funds had been received for the road project, Blackjack Grove Day would be held on May 14th, with the parade starting at I-30 Fastmart with lineup at 10:30 a.m. and if anyone was free and would like to help the Food Pantry that they needed assistance on Monday morning at 9:30 a.m. at the church on League Street, Sulphur Springs. Also announced was that David Petty would be the parade marshal for the Blackjack Grove parade and Doug Simmerman won first place in the Cumby Education Foundation's Ice Cream Cook-off and was featured on the front page of the Front Porch News.

Paul Robertson reported for the police department for April as 259 traffic citations issued, 6 arrests, 3 traffic accidents and 8 calls to assist other agency.
 - B) Public Works
Johnny Carter reported that the new truck has been picked up, work at the park for Blackjack Grove Day was being done, new playground equipment installed, road repairs were in process, the annual water reports have been submitted to the Texas Water Development Board and the system totals report submitted for April for the utility system showing water sold, gallons of water pumped and the water loss as 6 percent.
