Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 4-0.

VII. Reports

A) Police Department

Chief Roberson reported the police department activity for May as 269 citations issued, 22 calls for service, 2 crash reports, 13 offense reports, 10 arrests with activity for June as 325 citations, 24 calls for service, 4 crash reports, 7 offense reports and 10 arrests.

B) Public Works


Leaks were repaired, sewer lines unstopped, lift station repairs being made and cleanup of streets and. System totals reports were submitted for the utility system showing the water sold, gallons of water pumped and the water loss for May as 6.15 percent and June as 3.07 percent.

C) Fire Department

Chief Heath McGraw submitted the report for May as 3 grass fires, 2 car fires, 6 medical calls, 6 motor vehicle accidents with 3 calls in the City and 14 in the county. There were 3 grass fires, 5 car fires, 5 medical calls, 10 motor vehicle accidents, 1 investigation/standby with 3 calls in the City and 18 in the county for the month of June.


VIII. Adjournment
