

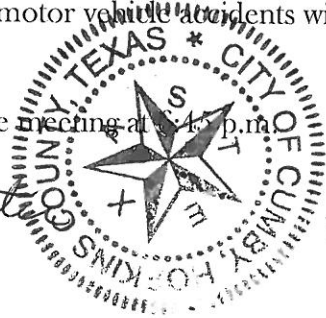
- I. Mayor Carter called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Oaths of Office were taken by Jackie Holley, Monty Lackey and Cody Talley. Monty Lackey took his position with the council for the meeting. The invocation was given by Deidre Maples and the pledge was recited by the Mayor, Council and Citizens in attendance.
- II. Announcements - Cumby will be playing in the bi-district football game will be held in Paris on Friday, November 17th at 7:00 p.m. This team holds the District Champion title for the first time. The Christmas parade will be held on December 19th with line up of the parade at 5:30 p.m. I-30 Fastmart. Blackjack Grove Daughters will be purchasing a public announcement (pa) system for use at the park. The Mayor thanked David Petty for his service as Alderman for the City.

- IV. Consent Agenda
Cody Talley moved to approve the consent agenda. Jackie Holley seconded, the motion passed 5-0.
- V. New Business
 - A) Jackie Holley moved to approve an exception allowing two (2) new mobile homes be placed on two (2) lots on Tarrant Street, replacing mobile homes previously located on these lots and the new homes will not be used as rental property for five (5) years from the placement date of the homes. Cody Talley seconded, the motion passed 5-0.
 - B) Jackie Holley moved to appoint Cody Talley as Mayor Pro Tem for 2017-2018. Robert Hines seconded, the motion passed 5-0.
- VI. Reports
 - A) Police Department
Chief Robertson reported the police department activity for October as 252 citations issued, 36 calls for service, 3 crash reports, 10 offense reports, 6 arrests.
 - B) Public Works
Leaks were repaired, sewer lines unstopped, lift station and treatment plant repairs being made and cleanup of streets and brush. Utility lines for the Family Dollar were being installed. System totals reports were submitted for the utility system showing the water sold, gallons of water pumped and the water loss for August as 1.16%.
 - C) Fire Department
Chief Heath McGraw submitted the report for October as 5 grass fires, 2 structure fires, 6 medical calls, 9 motor vehicle accidents with 4 calls in the City and 17 in the county.


VII. Adjournment
