- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:30 p.m.

Johnny Carter reported water leaks repaired and continued improvements at the sewer plant. System totals report was submitted for the utility system showing the water sold, gallons of water pumped and the water loss for October as 4.27 percent.
