

- I. Mayor Kathy Carter called the meeting order at 6:32 p.m.

  - C) David Petty moved to add the Cumby Volunteer Fire Department's Engine 111 (1985 Ford) to the City's automobile insurance policy. Cody Talley seconded, the motion passed 5-0.
- VI. Reports
  - A) Maintenance Department  
Water leaks were repaired, sewer lines sewer lines blown out, maintenance and upgrading at the treatment plant, decorations have been placed at the park for the holidays and the water loss for November was 3.95 percent.
  - B) Police Department  
Paul Robertson stated there were 351 total citations issued in November with 30 calls for service and 14 arrests.
  - C) Fire Department  
Interim Chief Heath McCraw submitted a report for the month of November with 3 grass fires, 6 structure fires, 8 medical calls, 14 motor vehicle accidents, 2 investigation/standbys with 7 calls in the city and 26 calls in the district.
