CITY COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 13, 2012
6:00 P.M.

THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2012, AT 6:00 PM, 100 E. MAIN STREET, CUMBY TEXAS.

THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: MAYOR JEFF STRICKLAND, ALDERMAN CHUCK TUGGLE, ALDERMAN CODY TALLEY, ALDERMAN KATHY HALL CARTER, ALDERMAN LARRY WHITE, ANGIE ALLEN, LANORA POWELL, SCOTT SEWELL, WANDA WALLACE, TRAVIS BAXLEY, PATRICIA HIGGINS, RAY HIGGINS.

1) MAYOR STRICKLAND CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:00 PM.

2) ALDERMAN TALLEY MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH MEETING. ALDERMAN WHITE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.

3) PRESENTATION FROM THE CITIZENS: PATRICIA HIGGINS STATED THAT THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH HAS HAD ISSUES WITH THE SEWER FLOODING THE BASEMENT OF THE CHURCH. THE CHURCH IS PLANNING ON REPLACING THE FLOORING AND WOULD LIKE THE CITY TO LOOK INTO THE PROBLEM. MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED THAT HE WOULD GET WITH ROGER PETTY AND HAVE A CHECK VALVE AND CUT OFF INSTALLED.

I WISH TO RESIGN MY POSITION AS ALDERMAN PLACE 2 ON THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUMBY EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND CONCEDE THE ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 6TH TO MS. LISA TAYLOR. SIGNED BILL JENKINS. MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED THAT THE CITY WILL CANVAS THE 2012 ELECTION RESULTS ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 14TH AT 7:00P.M. ANGIE ALLEN STATED THAT ONLY 2 MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL NEED TO BE PRESENT TO CANVAS THE ELECTION RESULTS AND THAT THE CANVASING HAS TO BE CONDUCTED BETWEEN NOVEMBER 14TH – NOVEMBER 19TH.
