VI. Police Department

A) Chief Scott Sewell reported the activities by the police department for the month of January as 190 citations issued, 1 misdemeanor arrest, 6 felony arrests, 6 incident reports, 4 offense reports and that 2 stolen vehicles were recovered. Chief Sewell submitted the 2013 racial profiling report to the Council for review.

B) Maintenance Department

Roger Petty that the streets are in need of repair and if weather holds up there is a crew coming in to Perform work on them. The Maintenance Department repaired 6 water leaks and the fire hydrant on Depot is leaking and will need repair and some leaks and wastewater repairs made still have clean up needed when the areas dry enough to complete.


C) Volunteer Fire Department
