I. Call To Order

IV. Consent Agenda

D) Mayor Carter and Council convened in to executive session at 6:51 p.m. Mayor Carter and Council reconvened in to open session at 7:05 p.m. A motion was made by Cody Talley to employ Brittany Johnston as Utility Clerk/Receptionist with a ninety day probationary period.

A) Chief Scott Sewell reported the activities by the police department for the month of March as 298 citations issued, 6 misdemeanor arrest, 2 felony arrests, 4 incident reports taken and 4 offense reports filed.

B) Maintenance Department

Mayor Carter reported that the water leak on Mill Street was repaired and there were several more leaks to be repaired.

C) Volunteer Fire Department


Report submitted by Tommy Faulknor had 31 calls for service which included 2 structure fires, 5 grass fires, 12 medical calls and 12 motor vehicle accidents. Mayor Carter also reported the fire department would be sounding the alarm on Wednesdays at 12:00 for testing.
