

- I. Mayor Kathy Hall Carter called the meeting order at 6:30 p.m.

  - A) Police Department  
Scott Sewell reported the activities by the police department for the months of May and June as 466 traffic citations issued, 3 accidents, 1 misdemeanor arrest, 2 felony arrests, 1 case filed with the district attorney and 3 cases filed with the county attorney.
  - B) Public Works  
Johnny Carter submitted a report with the work performed in the system during May and June. System total reports were submitted for the utility system showing water sold, gallons of water pumped and the loss percentage for May & June.
  - C) Fire Department  
Tommy Faulknor submitted a report for May with 9 medical calls, 10 motor vehicle accidents, 2 grass fires, 2 structure fires and 1 investigation/standby with 8 of the calls being in the City and 15 in their district.
