

CITY OF CUMBY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JANUARY 3, 2012

THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 3, 2012, AT 6:00 PM, 100 E. MAIN STREET, CUMBY TEXAS.

THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: MAYOR JEFF STRICKLAND, ALDERMAN CHUCK TUGGLE, ALDERMAN BILL JENKINS, ALDERMAN CODY TALLEY, ALDERMAN KATHY HALL CARTER, ALDERMAN LARRY WHITE, CHIEF SCOTT SEWELL, ANGIE ALLEN, JERRY PARKER.

1) MAYOR STRICKLAND CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:00 PM.

2) ALDERMAN TUGGLE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MONTH MEETING. ALDERMAN JENKINS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.

3) PRESENTATION FROM THE CITIZENS: NONE

4) OLD BUSINESS:

A) STREETS: WILL BE PATCHED AS NEEDED.

B) WATER FACILITIES: WELLS PUMPED 2,691,150, WATER SOLD 1,844,700, THE WWTP & CHURCHES USED 210,350. THERE WAS A LOSS OF 136,562 GALLONS. 203 POUNDS OF CHLORINE WERE USED.

C) SEWER PLANT: ROGER PETTY STATED THAT HE NEEDED TO ORDER POLIMAR FOR THE WWTP. THE COUNCIL APPROVED THE REQUEST.

D) WELL SITUATION: WELLS ARE RUNNING GOOD.

E) LEAK SITUATION: NEW FIRE HYDRANT INSTALLED ON MILL STREET. LEAKS REPAIRED ON MILL, COMMERCE, DONELTON, & DEPOT STREETS.

5) NEW BUSINESS:

A) DISCUSS / ACTION – ORDINANCE THE POSTING, DISTRIBUTION AND HAND DELIVERY OF, FLYERS, HAND BILLS , NEWS PRINT ADVERTISING, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CUMBY.

THIS ORDINANCE STATES:

IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITIZENS OF CUMBY TO CREATE A NEAT AND ORDERLY APPEARANCE THROUGHOUT OUR CITY;

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO POST, DISTRIBUTE OR HAND DELIVER ANY FLYER, HANDBILL OR NEWSPRINT ADVERTISING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CUMBY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE MAYOR.

ONLY DAILY OR WEEKLY NEWSPAPERS MAY BE DISTRIBUTED AND ONLY TO THOSE CITIZENS THAT HAVE SUBSCRIBED FOR SUCH DELIVERY.

ALDERMAN TUGGLE MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THIS ORDINANCE AS WRITTEN. ALDERMAN TALLEY SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED. THIS ORDINANCE WILL BE NUMBERED 2012-1.

B) DISCUSS FRISCO STREET PROJECT:

MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED THAT ALL EASEMENTS ARE SIGNED. ANGIE ALLEN WILL FILE EASEMENTS WITH THE COUNTY CLERK. MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED THAT PICTURES ARE TO BE TAKEN ON ALL PROPERTY ON FRISCO STREET.

6) POLICE DEPT. – CHIEF SEWELL: FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY THERE WERE A TOTAL OF 154 CITATIONS ISSUED, 4 OFFENSE REPORTS, 1 MISD. ARRESTS, 3 FELONY ARRESTS, 1 CASES FILED WITH THE COUNTY ATTORNEY, 3 CASES FILED WITH THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY.

7) PAY MONTHLY BILLS: ALDERMAN TALLEY MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE MONTHLY BILLS. ALDERMAN WHITE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.

8) ITEMS FROM COUNCIL: MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED THAT THE CITY WILL TAKE SEALED BIDS ON THE OLD MAINTENANCE TRUCK AND POLICE CAR. PUBLISH IN THE PAPER, OPEN BIDS ON NEXT COUNCIL MEETING.

9) THE CITY COUNCIL WILL NOW GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION – UNDER ARTICLE 6252-17 OF THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW. ALDERMAN JENKINS MADE A MOTION TO GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION UNDER ARTICLE 6252-17 OF THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW TO DISCUSS PERSONNEL. THE MAYOR STATED THE TIME AS 6:40 PM. ALDERMAN HALL-CARTER SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.
