CITY COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 11, 2008

THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON TUESDAY,
NOVEMBER 11, 2008, AT 7:00 PM, AT 101 MAIN STREET IN CUMBY, TEXAS.

THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: MAYOR JEFF STRICKLAND,

- 1) MAYOR STRICKLAND CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND LET EVERYONE KNOW THAT COMMISSIONER BAXLEY WOULD NOT BE PRESENT DUE TO ILLNESS.
- 2) COMMISSIONER HIGGINBOTHAM MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING. MAYOR STRICKLAND SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.
- 3) PRESENTATION BY THE CITIZENS: NONE
- 4) OLD BUSINESS
 - A) STREETS: SAME
 - B) WATER: WELLS PUMPED 3,128,000. WATER SOLD 1,763,700. WWTP & CHURCHES PUMPED 550,140. THERE WAS A LOSS OF 814,160. 218 POUNDS OF CHLORINE WERE USED.
 - C) SEWER PLANT: GOOD SHAPE. ROGER LET THE COUNCIL KNOW THAT HE IS NEEDING A DUMPSTER FOR THE SLUDGE, WE ALSO NEED A LOAD OF MORTAR SAND.
 - D) FIRE PLUGS: ROGER TO CHECK ON PARTS FOR THE HYDRANT ON DEPOT STREET.

 - F) LEAK SITUATION: REPAIRING AS NEEDED.

 - A) RAY VANN - RESOLUTION AMEND CONTRACT 726026: THE AMENDED RESOLUTION STATES:
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A CONTRACT AMENDMENT REQUEST FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CUMBY AND THE OFFICE OF RURAL COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM CONTRACT NUMBER 726026.

RANDY PRICE HAS RUBBLE WE CAN GET FOR THE ROAD. IF GROUND IS DRY THE LIFT STATION WILL BE DELIVERED THE WEEK OF NOV. 17TH IF NOT DRY ENOUGH WILL BE DELIVERED THE WEEK AFTER THANKSGIVING.

6) FIRE DEPT: FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER THERE WERE A TOTAL OF 33 CALLS. 7 CITY, 26 COUNTY, 6 GRASS FIRE, 2 CAR FIRE, 2 STRUCTURE FIRE, 18 MEDICAL, 4 MVC, 1 INVESTIGATION. THE FIRE DEPT. RECEIVED A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,800.00 TO PURCHASE AIRPACKS.
