CITY COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 1, 2010

THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON MONDAY,
NOVEMBER 1, 2010, AT 7:00 PM, 100 E. MAIN STREET, CUMBY TEXAS.

THE FOLLOWING WERE PRESENT: MAYOR JEFF STRICKLAND, ALDERMAN
CHUCK TUGGLE, ALDERMAN BILL JENKINS, ALDERMAN BRIAN SEELY,
ALDERMAN KATHY HALL CARTER, ALDERMAN LEON HIGGINBOTHAM, CITY
SECRETARY ANGIE ALLEN, CHIEF SCOTT SEWELL, LaNORA POWELL, ANGELA
LEE, JUDY MACHEN, TRAVIS BAXLEY.

1) MAYOR STRICKLAND CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

2) ALDERMAN HIGGINBOTHAM MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES
FROM ALL THE PREVIOUS MONTHS MEETINGS. ALDERMAN JENKINS SECONDED
THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.

3) PRESENTATION FROM THE CITIZENS: NONE

4) OLD BUSINESS:

A) STREETS: PATCHED MILL, SAYLE CIRCLE, & FRISCO STREETS

B) WATER FACILITIES: WELLS PUMPED 3,127,400. WATER SOLD 2,174,200.
THE WWTP & CHURCHES USED 473,060. THERE WAS A LOSS OF 480,140.
263 POUNDS OF CHLORINE WERE USED.

C) SEWER PLANT: ROGER PETTY STATED THAT HE SPOKE WITH INSPECTOR
BELZER WITH TCEQ ABOUT THE WEIR SITUATION. INSPECTOR BELZER
STATED THAT AN ENGINEER IS NOT NEED FOR THE WEIR REPAIR; THE
CITY CAN CALL IT SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE. ROGER PETTY WILL GET A
BID FROM FERRIN LONG. THE PADDLE WHEELS ARE COMPLETE FOR THE
WWTP; A NEW GEAR BOX IS NEEDED. THE COUNCIL STATED THAT ROGER
COULD ORDER A NEW GEAR BOX.

D) WELL SITUATION: WELL # 2 ROGER PETTY STATED THAT HE WOULD
CONTACT JEFF BERRY WITH DEVICE CALLIBRATION SERVICES TO COME
RUN A TEST ON THE METER TO DETERMINE IF IT NEEDS TO BE REPLACED.

E) LEAK SITUATION: 10 LEAKS FIXED IN MONTH OF OCTOBER.

5) NEW BUSINESS:

A) **SELLING OF USED EQUIPMENT:** MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED THE
CITY HAS USED EQUIPMENT THAT NEEDS TO BE SOLD. MAYOR STRICKLAND
SUGGESTED THAT THE CITY SELL THE FORD TRACTOR & OLD CASE BACKHOE
AND KEEP THE DUMP TRUCK AND SHREDDER. ALDERMAN TUGGLE STATED
THAT THE CITY COULD SELL THE EQUIPMENT AT BARTLEYS AUCTION HOUSE IN
SULPHUR SPRINGS. MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED FOR ANGIE ALLEN TO
CONTACT BARTLEYS AUCTION HOUSE & FIND OUT THE PROCEDURES ON HOW

TO PUT THE EQUIPMENT FOR SALE THROUGH THE AUCTION HOUSE. ALDERMAN TUGGLE MADE A MOTION TO CONTACT BARTLEYS ABOUT AUCTIONING THE OLD CASE BACK HOE & FORD TRACTOR. ALDERMAN JENKINS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.


B) UPGRADE PUMPHOUSE PLUMBING: MAYOR STRICKLAND STATED THAT THE PUMPHOUSE PLUMBING NEEDS TO BE REPLACED. PER TCEQ REGULATIONS THE CITY WILL HAVE TO HAVE AN ENGINEER TO DRAW UP PLANS. ALDERMAN SEELY MADE A MOTION TO TABLE THE PUMPHOUSE UPGRADING. ALDERMAN TUGGLE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.

6) POLICE DEPARTMENT / CHIEF SEWELL: FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER THERE WERE A TOTAL OF 428 CITATIONS ISSUED. 8 OFFENSE REPORTS TAKEN. 6 MISD. ARRESTS, 3 FELONY ARRESTS, 5 CASES FILED WITH THE COUNTY ATTORNEY, 2 CASES FILED WITH THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY.

7) PAY MONTHLY BILLS: ALDERMAN TUGGLE MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE MONTHLY BILLS. ALDERMAN JENKINS SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL APPROVE. MOTION PASSED.

8) ITEMS FROM THE COUNCIL: ALDERMAN JENKINS STATED THAT PER TCEQ AND CITY ORDINANCE 2007-1 THE CITY OF CUMBY REQUIRES ONE WATER METER PER RESIDENCE. THERE ARE SEVERAL HOUSE IN THE CITY THAT HAS MORE THAN ONE RESIDENCE CONNECTED TO THE METER. ALDERMAN JENKINS SUGGESTED THAT THE CITY SEND A LETTER TO THE NON COMPLIANCE RESIDENCE AND LET THEM KNOW THAT THE CITY WILL GIVE THEM A FREE TAP & THAT THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY A DEPOSIT ON EACH METER.

WITH ALL BUSINESS COMPLETE THE MEETING WAS ADJORNED AT 8 PM.
