

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR A ONE-WAY ROAD UPON A CERTAIN DESIGNATED PORTION OF DONELTON STREET AND DESIGNATED TIMES AND ONLY ON SCHOOL DAYS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY; AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT, DESIGNATION, MARKING AND SIGNING OF SAID ONE-WAY AREAS AND TIMES; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR THE DRIVER, OPERATOR, OR OWNER OR FOR THE OWNER TO PERMIT THE DRIVER OR OPERATOR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO DRIVE ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF SAID STREET ONE-WAY AT CERTAIN TIMES; PROVIDING FOR ASSUMPTIONS OF EVIDENCE; MAKING ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY PORTION OR PROVISIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, UPON CONVICTION THEREFORE, PUNISHABLE BY FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$200.00; PROVING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FULL FORCE ON AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS

I.

That the passage of a motor vehicle in and upon certain portions of said Donelton Street, from the point of Sayle Circle to Sayle St. in a Northerly Direction, be and is hereby prohibited from 7:30am to 9:30am and from 2:30pm to 4:30pm on school days, other than at such times when a motor vehicle is an emergency vehicle in the actual process of an emergency.

II.

As used herein, motor vehicle shall mean all forms of motor propelled vehicles, including but not limited to, automobiles, pickup trucks, motorcycles, and buses.

III.

There shall be erected and maintained on Donelton Street upon each intersecting roadway, within the corporate limits of said City, appropriate signs reflecting the words " ONE WAY" and stated below the sign the time that it is in affect. The size and lettering and colors of said sign shall comply and be in conformance with the applicable requirement of State Law.

IV.

It shall be unlawful and an offense for the driver, operator, or owner, or to permit the driver or operators of a motor vehicle to drive in a Northerly Direction during times set forth in Section I herein above, after the erection of signs as set forth in Section III hereof.

V.

It shall be the duty of the personnel of the Police Department of said City to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

VI.

Any person violating any portion or provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefore, shall be punished by a fine not more that \$200.00.

VII.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in direct conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of conflict only.


VIII.

Should any section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause or phrase hereof be held to be invalid, void, or unconstitutional for any reason, such holding shall not render invalid, void or unconstitutional, any other section, subsection, sentence, provision, clause or phrase of this ordinance, and the same shall be deemed severable for this purpose.

IX.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on and after its passage and publication, and it is so ordained.


