

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-7

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE RATES CHARGED BY THE CITY FOR WATER UTILITY SERVICE, AND STATING THE CURRENT RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE, TRASH COLLECTION SERVICE WHICH SHALL ALSO BE BILLED CONCURRENT WITH THE WATER UTILITY SERVICE BILL; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT, AFTER THE 3rd DAY OF July, 2001

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1 Water rates charged by the City shall be charged on a monthly basis for water provided to all domestic and commercial customers as follows:

- a) Customers within the corporate limits of the City:
 - 1) 01 - 2,000 gallons: \$16.00
 - 2) 2,001 - or more gallons: \$3.05 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof.
- b) Customers outside the corporate limits of the City:
 - 1) 0,001 - 2,000 gallons: \$25.00
 - 2) 2001 - or more gallons: \$3.30 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof.

SECTION 2 The sewer rates for the City shall be the sum of \$14.50 per month to all customers, commercial or domestic, connected to the City's sewer system.

SECTION 3 (Trash Collection) The City shall charge the sum of ^{12.00}~~\$10.00~~ per month to all customers, commercial or domestic, subscribing to trash collection within the corporate limits of the City, and the sum of ~~\$13.50~~ ^{14.50} per month to all customers subscribing to trash collection outside the corporate limits of the City.

SECTION 4 The following fees shall be charged for water service (tap fee):

- a. Residential: \$750.00
- b. Commercial: \$750.00

The sum of \$500.00 shall be charged to all customers, residential and commercial, for sewer service (sewer tap fee).

SECTION 5
(Penalty Fee)

The City shall charge and shall be entitled to collect a penalty of \$10.00 for all utility bills that have not been paid on or before the 10th day of each month, for the services received for the preceding monthly billing period.

SECTION 6

If any section, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be held for any reason to be illegal, ultra vires or unenforceable for any reason, then such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.


SECTION 7


SECTION 8
