

ORDINANCE 2012-1

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS;
REGULATING THE POSTING, DISTRIBUTION AND HAND
DELIVERY OF, FLYERS, HAND BILLS, NEWS PRINT
ADVERTISING, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF CUMBY.**

SECTION I.

IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITIZENS OF CUMBY TO CREATE A NEAT AND ORDERLY APPEARANCE THROUGHOUT OUR CITY;

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO POST, DISTRIBUTE OR HAND DELIVER ANY FLYER, HANDBILL OR NEWSPRINT ADVERTISING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CUMBY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE MAYOR.

ONLY DAILY OR WEEKLY NEWSPAPERS MAY BE DISTRIBUTED AND ONLY TO THOSE CITIZENS THAT HAVE SUBSCRIBED FOR SUCH DELIVERY.

SECTION II.

ANY INDIVIDUAL, ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION VIOLATING ANY PART OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE DEEMED GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, UPON CONVICTION THEREFORE, SHALL BE PUNISHED BY THE ASSESSMENT OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) AND A SEPERATE OFFENCE SHALL BE DEEMED COMMITTED UPON EVERY DAY DURING OR ON WHICH A VIOLATION OCCURS OR CONTINUES.

SECTION III.

SEVERENCE CLAUSE; THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE ARE DECLARED TO BE SEVERABLE AND IF ANY SECTION, SENTENCE, CLAUSE, OR PHRASE OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL FOR ANY REASON BE HELD TO BE INVALID OR UNCONSTITUTIONAL, SUCH DECISION SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF THE REMAINING SECTIONS, SENTENCES, CLAUSES AND PHRASES OF THIS ORDINANCE BUT THEY SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT, IT BEING THE LEGISLATIVE INTENT THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL STAND NOTWITHSTANDING THE INVALIDITY OF ANY PART.

SECTION IV.

ALL ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE, BE AND THE SAME ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

SECTION V.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE.
