

ORDINANCE NO. 55-1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES UPON THE STREETS IN THE CITY OF CUMBY, HOPKINS COUNTY, TEXAS, PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUMBY:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive any motor or other vehicle upon the public streets of the City of Cumby, Texas, at a rate of speed in excess of thirty (30) miles an hour, which maximum speed limit shall be applicable upon all the streets within said City, except as hereinafter specified and provided for certain designated streets and portions of streets.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive any motor or other vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of that specified for the following streets and portions of streets.

- (a) On F.M. Highway 275 southerly from the North City Limit of Cumby a distance of approximately 0.082 miles, a speed limit of sixty (60) miles per hour at all times; thence southerly to the intersection of F.M. Highway 499, a distance of approximately 0.250 miles, a speed limit of forty-five (45) miles per hour at all times and, southerly from the intersection of F.M. Highway 499 a distance of approximately 0.200 miles, a speed limit of thirty-five (35) miles per hour at all times; thence southerly to the intersection of I.H. 30, a distance of approximately 0.348 miles, a speed limit of forty (40) miles per hour at all times as evidenced by the attached plan which is hereby approved and made a part hereof.
- (b) On F.M. Highway 499 easterly from the West City Limit of Cumby a distance of approximately 0.276 miles, a speed limit of forty-five (45) miles per hour at all times and, westerly from the East City Limit of Cumby on F.M. Highway 499, a distance of approximately 0.200 miles, a speed limit of forty-five (45) miles per hour at all times as evidenced by the attached plan which is hereby approved and made a part hereof.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective the 2 day of Feb 1965.
