

ORDINANCE NO. 80-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, PROHIBITING DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE; REPEALING PROVISIONS OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING ORDINANCE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS:

I

The firing of any firearm at any time within the corporate limits of the City is hereby prohibited, except by duly qualified and appointed law enforcement officers in the performance of their duties or by a party issued a special permit in accordance with Section II below.

II

Any party who operates a gallery, gunsmith establishment or other business in which the discharge of a firearm is necessary to conduct said business, may apply to the City Commission for a permit excepting him from Section I above.

III

Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1.00, nor more than \$200.00; and each and every discharge of a firearm in violation hereof, shall be deemed a separate offense and punishable as such.

IV

This Ordinance shall supercede any prior ordinances in conflict herewith, and such prior conflicting ordinances, if any, are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict with this Ordinance.

V

An emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of the general welfare of the citizens of Cumby, Texas, therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately.

VI

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be illegal, ultra vires or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
