

ORDINANCE NO. 81-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 73-9 OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, PASSED ON JUNE 19, 1973; DESIGNATING JENKINS STREET AS AN ADDITIONAL TRUCK ROUTE; REPEALING PROVISIONS OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING ORDINANCE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS:

I

Section 2 entitled Designation of Ordinance No. 73-9 of the City of Cumby, Texas, is hereby amended to include Jenkins Street in its entire length within the corporate limits as one of the designated truck routes within said city.

II

This Ordinance shall supercede any prior ordinances in conflict herewith, and such prior conflicting ordinances are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict with this Ordinance.

III

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be illegal, ultra vires or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

IV

An emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of the general welfare of the citizens of Cumby, Texas, therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
