

ORDINANCE NO. 84-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, PROHIBITING CERTAIN USES OF WATER PROVIDED THE CITY'S WATER CUSTOMERS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE; REPEALING PROVISIONS OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING ORDINANCE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS:

I

The use of water by the city's customers is hereby prohibited for watering lawns, trees, shrubs, and flowers, to wash vehicles of any type, or to wash building exterior walls, windows, porches, and ornamental trim.

II

Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$200.00 for the first conviction; and by a fine of \$200.00 for the second conviction; and upon the third conviction for violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance such person shall have water service discontinued.

III

This ordinance shall supersede any prior ordinances in conflict herewith, and such prior conflicting ordinance, if any, are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict with this ordinance.


IV

An emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of the general welfare of the citizens of Cumby, Texas, therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication.

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be illegal, ultra vires or unconstitutional, such invalidity shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.


