AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY, FIXING THE RATE THEREOF, PROVIDING THE DATE FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH TAXES AND FOR DISCOUNTS THEREOF; PROHIBITING THE PARTIAL PAYMENT OF CERTAIN TAXES; AND, PROVIDING THAT SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FULL FORCE IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS:

I

There is hereby levied, and there shall be collected, for the use and support of the municipal government of the said City of Cumby, Texas, for the calendar year 1984-85, upon all property, whether real, personal or mixed, with the corporate limits of said City and subject to taxation, a tax of \$0.21 on each \$100.00 valuation of such property.

II

The taxes hereinabove levied shall be due on the 1st day of October, 1984, and if not paid by the first day of February, 1985, such unpaid taxes shall be then and there delinquent and subject to the added penalty, interest and costs as provided by law, which said penalties, interest and costs shall be added by the Collector of Taxes for said City and collected as provided by law.

III

Said Collector of Taxes shall not accept any partial payment of any taxes due the City of Cumby, Texas, for which said Collector of Taxes is responsible for collecting, but shall accept only a full payment of any taxes due and payable said City.

IV

For the purpose of encouraging and inducing the payment of said taxes due said City before the 1st day of February, 1985, percentage discounts on full payments shall be allowed and are as follows, to-wit:

For full payment in October and November 1984	3%
For full payment in December 1984	2%
For full payment in January 1985	1%

The said Collector of Taxes of said City shall keep said accounts so as to readily and distinctly show the amount collected, the amounts expended, and the amount on hand at any time.

VI

If any section, part or provision of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, then in that event, it is expressly provided, and it is the intention of the City Commission in passing this ordinance, that other parts of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

VII

All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

VIII

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval, and it is so ordained.
