

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, DESIGNATING CERTAIN PARKING SPACES IN THE 131 BLOCK OF MAIN STREET, IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO THE POST OFFICE AS RESERVED PARKING SPACES WITH A LIMITATION OF FIFTEEN MINUTES; PROVIDING THAT VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS:

Section 1:

That the Chief of Police of the City of Cumby, Texas, is hereby authorized to designate two parking spaces in the 131 Block of Main Street, immediately adjacent to and in front of the United States Post Office for the City of Cumby, Texas, as reserved parking spaces with a parking time limit of fifteen (15) minutes. Said reserved parking places shall be appropriately marked so as to inform the general public of their reserved nature and limited parking time. After the aforesaid parking spaces have been so designated no person shall park any type of motor vehicle in such spaces for a period longer than fifteen (15) minutes.

Section 2:

Any person that violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon final conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$200.00.

Section 3:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of conflict only.

Section 4:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
