

ORDINANCE NO. 87-1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS ON FM HWY 499, AND AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ENFORCE SUCH SPEED LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Cumby desire and have requested a lower speed limit on FM Hwy 499 due to heavy traffic in that area, and

WHEREAS, the speed limits now being 45 miles per hour inside the corporate limits in certain areas on FM Hwy 499,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Cumby, Texas: The speed limit shall be reduced on FM Hwy 499 to 30 miles per hour at the ~~easterly~~ ^{east} boundary of the corporate limits which is located at the junction of M & R Drive and FM Hwy 499, and shall remain at 30 miles per hour on FM Hwy 499 inside the corporate limits of the City of Cumby, Texas until reaching the easterly boundary of the corporate limits located at approximately the property known as 402 East Main Stree,

THEREFORE, The City Commission of the City of Cumby, Texas hereby instructs the Police Department of said city to issue citations for speeding in this area as would be in any other area of the city.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
