

ORDINANCE NO. 87-2

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS ON F. M. HIGHWAY 499, AND AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ENFORCE SUCH SPEED LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the District Traffic Engineering staff of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation have conducted an engineering study; and

WHEREAS, it was their decision that based on the results of their study, only one speed zone change can be made at the present time;


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Cumby, Texas: The speed limit shall be reduced on the west side of Cumby on F. M. Highway 499, beginning at the city limits and extending eastward 0.276 miles to 40 miles per hour;

THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Cumby, Texas hereby instructs the Police Department of said city to issue citations for speeding in this area as would be in any other area of the City;

THEREFORE, all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
