ORDINANCE NO. 88-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS, PROHIBITING ENTRY UPON THE CUMBY CITY CEMETERY PREMISES BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SUNSET AND SUNRISE; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and welfare to regulate the hours and use of the Cumby City Cemetery;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CUMBY, TEXAS:

Section 1:

Except as otherwise provided herein, no person or persons shall enter upon or use the Cumby City Cemetery premises between the hours of sunset and sunrise.

Section 2:

The curfew provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall not apply to the grounds maintenance personnel when in the act of performing their duties.

Section 3:

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon final conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor to exceed \$200.00.

Section 4:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extend of conflict only.

Section 5:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication.
